- <u>USFS Rules</u>: All vehicles in the sno-parks must display in the windshield a 2023-24 OR, ID or CA sno-park permit. Any straw not contained must be "Certified Weed-Free".
- <u>Race Notes</u>: Mandatory drivers' meeting for all racers will be at the Wanoga Sno-Park at the warming shelter on each day one hour before race start. Helmets are suggested for all participants and strongly recommended for juniors. Metal-edge skis prohibited in skijoring events.
